

HMA FAQ's

- When are lessons offered? Lessons are typically offered weekday evenings between 4-8 p.m. Not all instruments are offered each day of the week, so actual lesson time depends on the type of lesson
- What ages may study music at the Hauser Music Academy? The Hauser Music Academy accepts students ages 5-adult for guitar, piano, and violin. Wind instrument students and vocalists must be at least 5th grade.
- Who serves on the faculty of the HMA? The HMA hires instructors with at least a Bachelor of Music degree, many with a Master of Music degree, who have experience and enjoy teaching all levels and ages of students.

* Can I begin lessons mid-semester? Lessons can begin anytime in the semester and the fee is pro-rated for the remaining lessons in the term.

Hauser Music Academy

The HMA is an outreach program which offers high-quality music instruction in piano, voice, guitar, violin, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, horn, trombone, and tuba at St. John's United Church of Christ at 7031 S. East St. (corner of U.S. 31 and Southport Rd.). The Academy is named in honor of Raymond G. Hauser, Jr., musician, educator, and St. John's UCC loyal member. Lessons are available for all ages and levels of experience.

Lessons are offered weekly for 30, 45 or 60 minutes. Cost is \$20 per half hour, \$30 for 45 minutes and \$40 for 60 minute lessons.
